

The Prophet's Peers

The Prophet's Family

Isaiah was the son of Amoz and he had two sons – Shearjashub (*Shě'ar Yashuwb*) and Mahershallhashbazz (*Maher Shalal Chash Baz*). His wife was unnamed, but in Isaiah 8:3, we are told that she was a prophetess.

Amoz – “Burdensome, to oppose, to afflict”

Isaiah – “The salvation of Yahweh’

Shearjashub – “The remnant shall return”

Mahershallhashbaz – “Speed the prey or haste the spoils”

King Uzziah- Strengthened by Yahweh

Also known as King Azariah – Helped by Yahweh

- **II Chronicles 26:1, 3** - He was 16 years old when he started to reign and reigned 52 years.
- **Verse 4-5** – He initially did that which was right in the sight of Yahweh
- **Verse 6-14** – He had a great army and was able to conquer many cities and was able to fortify Jerusalem. He also built Jerusalem and Judah into a great agricultural society –see verse 10.
- **Verse 15** – The divine historian tells us under his reign, new weapons of warfare were introduced
- We see also in **verse 15**, the fulfillment of the meaning of his name – He was helped, strengthened by Yahweh
- **Verse 16** through the end of the chapter teach us of his tragic downfall. Because of his esteemed position, he thought that he could also assume the role of high priest. He went into the temple of the Lord and tried to offer incense upon the altar of incense. He was stopped by Azariah the priest along with 80 other valiant priests.
- As a result of this presumptuous act, King Uzziah was struck with leprosy and lived the remainder of his life in a separate house.
- **II Kings 15:4** presents the spiritual condition of the Nation of Judah during his reign – “The people sacrificed and burnt incense still on the high places”.

King Jotham – Yahweh is perfect or upright

- **II Corinthians 27** - He was 25 years old when he began to reign and reigned for 16 years, making him 41 years old when he died.
- **Verse 2** states that he did that which was right in the sight of the Lord. He did not commit the same sin that his father committed.
- He built additional cities in Israel.
- He defeated the Ammonites and caused them to pay tribute.
- He became mighty because he prepared his ways before Yahweh.
- In **II Chronicles 27:2** and **II Kings 15:35**, we read of the spiritual condition of the tribes of Judah during the reign of King Jotham. In **II Chronicles 27:2**, we read that the people of the land did yet corruptly and in **II Kings 15:35**, we read of the evil condition of Judah. The high places were not removed, the people sacrificed and burned incense still in the high places.

King Ahaz - Possessor

- **II Chronicles 28** - He was 20 years old when he began to reign and reigned for 16 years, making him 36 years old when he died.
- Did not do that which was right in the sight of Yahweh. Followed wicked ways of Israel's kings
- He burnt incense to the gods of the nations around Judah and offered his children in fire to the pagan gods.
- Judah was attacked and taken captives many times during his reign, by the Syrians, by their brothers in the ten tribes of Israel, by the Assyrians, by the Edomites, and by the Philistines.
- He gave portions of the articles in the Lord's temple to the King of Assyria.
- He defiled the altar of incense and the brazen altar of burnt offerings – **II Kings 17:14-17**.
- **II Chronicles 28:22** presents the summary of his life – “In the time of his distress did he trespass yet more against the Lord; this is that king Ahaz”.
- In **II Chronicles 28:19**, the inspired word tells us that Yahweh made Judah weak because of the evil acts of this evil king. The leaven was allowed to fester and finally grew to the point that the apostate paganism was in every city of Judah – **II Chronicles 28:25**. **II Chronicles 28:19** – Judah was made naked by this evil and wicked king. In a spiritual sense, the garments of salvation had been taken away and the wickedness of the flesh had been exposed. **II Chronicles 28:24** tell us that the doors of the temple were closed under king Ahaz. The means of salvation were made unavailable.

Hezekiah – Strengthened of Yahweh

II Chronicles 31:20-21

And thus did Hezekiah throughout all Judah, and wrought *that which was* good and right and truth before the LORD his God. And in every work that he began in the service of the house of God, and in the law, and in the commandments, to seek his God, he did *it* with all his heart, and prospered.

II Kings 18:3-7

And he did *that which was* right in the sight of the LORD, according to all that David his father did. He removed the high places, and brake the images, and cut down the groves, and brake in pieces the brasen serpent that Moses had made: for unto those days the children of Israel did burn incense to it: and he called it Nehushtan. He trusted in the LORD God of Israel; so that after him was none like him among all the kings of Judah, nor *any* that were before him. For he clave to the LORD, *and* departed not from following him, but kept his commandments, which the LORD commanded Moses. And the LORD was with him; *and* he prospered whithersoever he went forth: and he rebelled against the king of Assyria, and served him not.

Six Woes of Isaiah 5

[Isa 5:8](#) Woe unto them that join house to house, *that* lay field to field, till *there be* no place, that they may be placed alone in the midst of the earth!

Additional 6 Woes

- **Isaiah 28:1** – Woe pronounced upon the proud and the spiritual and literal drunkards
- **Isaiah 29:1** – Woe pronounced upon Jerusalem through the coming judgments against the city.
- **Isaiah 29:15** – Woe to those who tried to hide their sins from Yahweh. They cover themselves with their own inventions.
- **Isaiah 30:1** – Woe again pronounced upon the rebellious attitude of the nation who did not seek counsel, guidance and protection from Yahweh.
- **Isaiah 31:1** – Woe pronounced upon them who put their trust in Egypt and not in Yahweh. See **Psalms 118:8**.
- **Isaiah 33:1** – This woe is pronounced against the spoiler of the nation – first Assyria in the days of Isaiah all the way through the Assyrian of the latter days – the Gogian invader.
