**28** But there is a God in heaven that revealeth secrets, and maketh known to the king Nebuchadnezzar **what shall be in the latter days.**





## Sevenfold destruction of the (10) enemies in the Sanctuary

- **Make them as a wheel (vs. 13 - a tumbleweed, cp. Isa. 17:13).**
- **As the stubble before the wind (vs. 13 - chaff, cp Daniel 2:35).**
- **As the fire burneth the wood (vs. 14 - where the wild boar, or Rome came from, Psalm 80:13).**
- **As the flame setteth the mountains on fire (vs. 14, cp. Isa. 30:30).**
- **So persecute them with thy tempest (vs. 15; cp. Isa. 28:2).**
- **Make them afraid with thy storm (vs. 15, cp. Nahum 1:3; Ezek. 1).**
- **Fill their faces with shame that they may seek Thy name, O LORD (vs. 16, cp. Isa. 65:13).**


And they shall call them, The holy people, The redeemed of Yahweh: and thou shalt be called, Sought out, **A city not forsaken.**




# Deu. 33:2


# Bozrah, Babylon, and Rome

**Bozrah** = sheepfold or fortress

Babylon (confusion) was in the plain of **Dura** = wall, rampart or dwelling

**Rome** in Hebrew (Romiith) = fortification

**dipped = bapto (Gk)**
